Quick Facts:

- The mission of the MTNA Composer Commissioning Program is to encourage the creation of new works by American composers.
- MTNA will match a state commission for an amount equal to the state's contribution up to \$750. (Oregon matches the full \$750, for a total award of \$1500.)
- The composer does not need to be a member of MTNA or to reside in the state in which commissioned.
- More than 30 states participated in the program last year.
- MTNA honors one of these commissioned works and its composer as the MTNA-Shepherd Distinguished Composer of the year and the new work of the selected composer is presented in a performance at the next MTNA national convention.
- The MTNA Distinguished Composer of the Year also receives a check for \$3000, generously funded by Dr. Sylvia Shepherd, MTNA member from California.

- Oregon's next commissioned composer will be announced at the 2012 conference. The work will be premiered at the 2013 conference.
