



OMTA State Ensemble Festival

The Russell Tripp Performance Center in Takena Hall, LBCC Albany Campus will be the site for the OMTA State Ensemble Festival. Linn Benton Community College will host the event.

Students will have the privilege of performing on LBCC's 9 foot Steinway – an artist model, and a Yamaha CFIIIs 9 foot concert grand, being provided by Lawson's Keyboards in Eugene.

A Reminder of District Chairperson Responsibilities

1. Remind and encourage your teachers to participate in this unique festival.
2. As your entries come in, be sure to check for accuracy, the age group, time and repertoire for each participant.
3. Because the ensemble festival is an OMTA function, a \$2.00 fee per students must be paid to the state. If a student plays twice, they pay a \$2.00 fee for each performance.
4. Be sure to set your district entry fee based on the amount of money you need to run the district festival and then add the \$2.00 fee to be paid to the State.
5. One week before the District Ensemble Festival takes place, the District Chair must mail the \$2.00 per student fee to the state treasurer. One check covering all performances should be written payable to OMTA.
6. After your district festival, ask each ensemble selected for state if they have a preference of days (not times) for the state recitals and mark it on the dual entry blank. Remind each group of the \$10.00 entry fee for the state recitals.
7. Send all the state entries to the state chair as soon as possible including the \$10.00 entry fee.
8. The teacher of the state ensemble group and the district chair will both be notified as soon as the 6 recitals are set.
