The purpose of this form is to track information related to the students who achieve Honorable Mention in the District Adjudication for the Composition Celebration. 1) For "Student Level" please use these abbreviations, and verify that they pay the correct fee:

PR is Primary (grade K-3 - fee is \$10)

EL is Elementary (grade 4-6 - fee is \$10)

JR is Jr. High (grade 7-9 - fee is \$15)

SR is Sr. High (grade 10-12 - fee is \$15)

CO is College (age 18-26 - fee is \$15)

AD is Adult (non-college, non-music degree, non-published - fee is \$15)

2) "Recital Group Times." If a teacher's group is traveling a long distance and desires to request a specific time for their recital, please indicate preferred recital (accommodation will be made for them as space allows): **A** from 2:00-3:00pm; **B** from 3:15-4:15pm; and **C** 4:30-5:30pm.

3) Please keep one sheet per teacher and tally the number of students who will attend the State Composition Celebration, whether fees were paid, and what amount was paid in the TOTALS line at the bottom of the chart. This form will be submitted to the State Chair with the completed student packets prior to May 1.
