Syllabus Adjudicator Certification Program

(Administered by the OMTA Syllabus Committee)

This certification program was established for OMTA syllabus adjudicators in June, 2000, to encourage and recognize the continuing growth of OMTA Syllabus Adjudicators and to help raise the standards of the OMTA syllabus Program. Certification as an adjudicator is recommended, but not required.

The **point** requirements **below** must be met to receive **OMTA Syllabus Adjudicator** certification. They were voted on and passed at the October, 2002, Adjudicator Retreat and revised in October, 2009 by the Syllabus Committee.

- A. Complete two years as a successful member of the OMTA Syllabus Adjudicating Staff, serving a minimum of 4 7-hour days.
- B. Accrue 20 points during a two-year period from the following categories:
 - 1. Continuing Adjudicator Training:
 - Annual Adjudicator Retreat 4 points _____
 - Annual OMTA conference 2 pts. Per day (6 max) _____
 - Includes Adjudicator meeting
 - 2. Serve as an OMTA Adjudicator
 - For each 7 hours 1 point (12 max) _____
 - 3. Participation in the Syllabus Program
 - For every 5 students who participate
 - Successfully (conference required)
 - 1 point (6 max) _____
 - 4. Attendance at:
 - Piano Festival Northwest 3 points (3 max) _____
 - MTNA National Conference 3 points (3 max) _____
