

# OMTA PARTICIPATION TROPHIES

## Guidelines & Procedures

Participation trophies, as of September 2011, are offered in five levels. They are available in green (10 points), purple (20 points), blue (30 points), silver (40 points) and gold (50 points). Each District has its own Participation Trophy Chair. Trophies are pictured on page 2 of this document.

### Guidelines:

- All OMTA/MTNA-sponsored events qualify for one trophy point.
- Oregon Junior Bach Festival, Ensemble Festival, Composition Celebration and MTNA Competitions qualify for one point at every level.
- There is no maximum number of points that can be earned in one year.
- Leftover points are to be added to the next trophy level.

### Procedures:

- Teachers submit orders and payment to the State Participation Trophy Chair, Heidi Evans, 20824 SW Teton Ave, Tualatin, OR 97062.
- Make checks payable to OMTA.
- Include MTNA documentation that verifies current membership.
- The State Chair informs the District Chair to release the trophies to the requesting teacher.
- The teacher contacts the District Chair to arrange for transfer of the trophies.
- The teacher is responsible for keeping records of their students' participation points.
- District Chairs are responsible for replenishing inventory and releasing trophies to teachers only upon notice from the State Chair.
